Students will work in small groups on various social problems in the global and local community, organized by social media as an overarching concern. This connects with

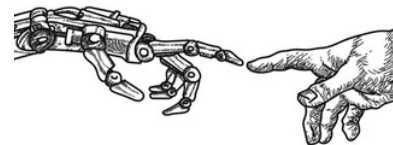
